March finally saw the Heritage Centre move forward as the Manawaru Historical Society welcomed back onboard Vicky Kelly to become the Heritage Centre Manager.

Vicky had previously worked with the Society while writing and compiling the 'Manawaruites' book back in 2018, and had served on the committee ever since.

The lease for the Heritage Centre was signed between the Society and Community View in October 2019, and curtains and shelves were installed to create an archive/work space.

Now work is progressing on foundation documents, grant applications and display design.

The Manawaru 120th Jubilee on 3rd to 5th April 2020, is a focus for the first displays that will be created — including a temporary display about the previous five jubilees.

The aim is to be fully open for the new spring season and official opening of the Hauraki Rail Trail in September 2020 — in the meantime — we would love donations with a story to display in our awesome new space!!
